— I went to river to collect water

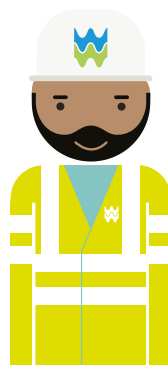
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Did you have enough water for all jobs? Did you have any left?
