Create a poem poster using at least one of each type of poems.

Type	Instructions	Example
Haiku	A 3 lined Japanese poem inspired by nature. 5 syllables 7 syllables 5 syllables	As the soft wind blows Across the trees, I see the Buds blooming in May
Tanka	A 5 lined Japanese poem. A beginning, middle and end. Line 3 ends the beginning of the poem and starts the end of the poem. 5 syllables 7 syllables 5 syllables 7 syllables 7 syllables	Walking over stones on the way to my calm pond I spot a heron I stop and hold very still watching it steal a small fish
Cinquain	A cinquain has 5 lines and looks like a diamond. 1 words (noun) 2 words (adjectives) 3 words (verbs) 4 words (a phrase) 1 word (synonym, relates to line 1)	Frog Green, warty, Hopping, munching, hiding King of the pond Amphibian
