Welsh Water cleans over 800 million litres of water per day and pipes it to our houses for us to use. A lot of energy is used pumping water to people's homes, this can be bad for the environment. Remember, you can help can save water in many ways: taking a shower instead of a bath, watering plants with a watering can instead of a hose pipe and **TURNING OFF DRIPPING TAPS!**

At our Discovery Centre we looked at how many litres we use per day when we are using water. Does this jog your memory? Remember that number of litres used can vary depending on how fast the water is flowing!



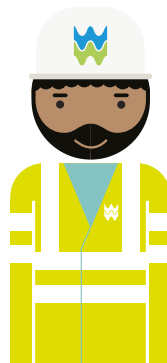
Persuade your schoolmates to start being water efficient; let them know what they can do to save water at school and at home.
