

We're upgrading the water pipes...

To provide you with clean, fresh water for years to come.

Hello

We just wanted to remind you about work to upgrade the water pipes in the area. As you are already aware, we need to do some work on our water network to make sure customers continue to receive a first class water supply every time they open the tap.

We're investing **£2 million** replacing parts of the water network in Porth and we want to let you know what that means for you.



Where and when?

You may have seen us working in the Porth area over the last few months and now it is time to carry out a section of work on Pontypridd Road. We will be renewing approximately **400 metres** of pipe on Pontypridd Road between the junctions with Hannah Street and Station Street. Work is due to commence during the third week of March and we anticipate that our section of work will be complete by the third week of May.

Rhondda Cynon Taff Council will then be carrying out work to repair a section of the river wall on Pontypridd Road. As long as everything goes to plan, Rhondda Cynon Taff should complete this section of work by the end of October.

To ensure that traffic continues to run as smoothly as possible, there will be diversionary routes in place for the duration of the work. Traffic into Porth town centre will be diverted through Hannah Street while all other traffic will be diverted via the by-pass.

We have been liaising with businesses in Porth to ensure delivery arrangements are in place to help keep businesses running as usual. Heavy goods vehicles (HGV's) will not be allowed to stop in Hannah Street while the road closure is in place. However, alternative arrangements have been made for these deliveries. A vehicle control officer will be available on site to assist with these deliveries.

Alternative parking has been arranged for traders during this time adjacent to Rheola Road, opposite the Rheola Hotel. Council Civil Enforcement Officers will also be active in the area to make sure that parking procedures are followed, especially in Hannah Street.

You may have noticed a new access road into Morrison's the A4058, this is temporary and will be put back to normal once the work has finished.

The bus stops on Pontypridd Road will be temporarily moved to the area opposite the junction of Station Street for the duration of this work. For more information about bus times and diversions please follow <https://bustimes.org/localities/porth-rhondda>.

We respectfully ask that no vehicles are parked within our working area for the duration of this work. We will do our very best to keep access for residents who live on Pontypridd Road clear at all times however, delays may sometimes be inevitable. Our contractors will work with residents and businesses to ensure any disruption is kept to a minimum. Pedestrian access will still be available during the road closure and access to Jenkins Street will also be available.

Ble a phryd?

Mae hi'n ddigon posibl eich bod chi wedi ein gweld ni'n gweithio yn ardal y Porth dros y misoedd diwethaf, ac mae'r amser wedi dod nawr i ni gyflawni gwaith ar Heol Pontypridd. Byddwn ni'n adnewyddu tua **400 metr** o bibellau ar **Heol Pontypridd** rhwng cyffyrdd Stryd Hannah a Stryd yr Orsaf. Disgwylir i'r gwaith gychwyn yn ystod trydedd wythnos Mawrth, ac rydyn ni'n rhagweld y byddwn wedi cwblhau'r rhan yma o'r gwaith erbyn trydedd wythnos Mai.

Bydd Cyngor Rhondda Cynon Taf yn mynd ati wedyn i gyflawni gwaith i drwsio rhan o wal yr afon ar Heol Pontypridd. Os bydd y cyfan yn mynd yn ôl y disgwyl, bydd Cyngor Rhondda Cynon Taf wedi cwblhau eu gwaith nhw erbyn diwedd Hydref.

Er mwyn cadw'r traffig yn llifo cystal â phosibl, bydd llwybrau gwyrdd yn weithredol trwy gydol y gwaith. Caiff traffig i ganol tref y Porth ei wyro ar hyd Stryd Hannah, a chaiff yr holl draffig orall ei wyro ar hyd y ffordd osgoi.

Rydyn ni wedi bod yn cydweithio â busnesau yn y Porth er mwyn sicrhau bod trefniadau ar waith i gludo nwyddau iddynt er mwyn cadw'r busnesau'n rhedeg fel arfer. Ni chaniateir i gerbydau nwyddau trwm (HGVs) stopio yn Stryd Hannah tra bod Heol Pontypridd ar gau. Ond gwnaed trefniadau amgen i'r cerbydau cludo nwyddau ddadlwytho ger Stryd Hannah. Bydd swyddog rheoli cerbydau ar gael ar y safle i helpu yn hyn o beth.

Gwnaed trefniadau parcio amgen ar gyfer masnachwyr ger Heol Rheola gyferbyn â Gwesty Rheola yn ystod y cyfnod hwn. Bydd Swyddogion Gorfodi Sifil y Cyngor yn weithredol yn yr ardal er mwyn sicrhau bod pobl yn dilyn y gweithdrefnau parcio, ac yn enw edig yn Stryd Hannah.

Mae'n bosibl eich bod wedi sylwi fod ffordd fynediad newydd i Morrisons ar yr A4058. Ffordd dros dro yw hon, a bydd y trefniadau mynediad arferol yn dychwelyd pan fyddwn wedi cwblhau'r gwaith.
