As part of the non-statutory consultation on our plans to invest in new and resilient water treatment works to safeguard and future proof the supply of water to our customers, we want to know what you think about our proposals.

This feedback form is to gather your views on the proposal to construct a new water treatment works in the Merthyr Tydfil area, at Dan-y-Castell Farm, along with a raw water pumping station at Pontsticill.

The feedback received as part of this consultation will help us shape and develop our proposals further, prior to us undertaking a statutory consultation, where the local community and stakeholders will again have the opportunity to review and provide comments on our plans.

As outlined in the consultation brochure, our revised proposals offer a split-site approach, this means we will need to consult on each proposal separately and submit separate planning applications for each proposal. We need to deliver both proposals to meet our legal duty to upgrade the water treatment processes.

Planning applications for our proposals will be submitted to the two relevant planning authorities, Merthyr Tydfil County Borough Council and Bannau Brycheiniog National Park Authority.

For this reason, there are separate feedback forms for each proposal so we can ensure that any comments received will be specific to each proposal. We welcome and encourage feedback on both proposals, for those who wish to comment on both you will need to complete the two feedback forms. This feedback form is for our proposed Dan-y-Castell Water Treatment Works and Pontsticill Pumping Station.
